Written statement of Behaviour Principles

We ensure every pupil has the right to feel safe, valued and respected, and is able to learn free from the disruption of others

All pupils, staff and visitors at Stone Bay school are free from any form of discrimination

Staff and volunteers set an excellent example to pupils at all times

Rewards and reasonable force are used consistently by staff, in line with the behaviour policy and PROACT SCIP UK philosophy.

The behaviour policy is shared and understood by all staff

The exclusions policy explains that exclusions will only be used as a last resort, and outlines the processes involved in suspensions and exclusions

When appropriate, pupils are taught the natural consequences of their behaviours

Staff communicate with families regarding behaviour incidents to foster good relationships between the school and pupils' home life

The governing board of Stone Bay school also emphasises that all behaviour pupils display, is seen as a form of communication.

Members of staff at Stone Bay school are to be responsive to pupils' needs and support appropriately. We promote a proactive approach to supporting pupils with any challenges that may arise.
